Doralou des Bordes' Brother Added as a Wild Card

Kefir des Bordes made a promising debut in a bumper. His pedigree is impeccable: this son of Tunis is the brother of Doralou des Bordes, winner of the Grand Cross de Craon, and his family has shone on both sides of the Channel and in all jumping disciplines.

Strong debuts for Kefir des Bordes

At the age of four, **Kefir des Bordes** (Tunis) made his competitive debut. On the flat at **Saint-Jean-de-Monts**, he finished second behind more seasoned horses, showing focus and determination.

Trainer **Erwan Grall** commented: *"He's a tall and was not precocious. He's already a very good jumper, but I chose to start him on the flat to teach him the ropes. He's a future steeplechaser, a fine horse who is now coming into his own."*

An exceptionally complete NH family

Kefir des Bordes boasts a very strong pedigree. The four-year-old gelding is by the stallion **Tunis** (Estejo), whose first crop has already produced black-type horses like **Ella Duchic** and **Kiss Langy**. Over 70% of Tunis's runners have earned prize money, with more than a third winning races.

On the dam's side, the pedigree is packed with top performers, starting with his brother, **Doralou des Bordes**, winner of the **2021 Grand Cross de Craon**. His dam, a daughter of **Nononito**, is a sister to **Lutin des Bordes** (Epervier Bleu), winner of 13 races, including two Listed cross-country events, and multiple Group 3 placings in chase. This family also includes **Olivia des Bordes**, a Listed winner in chase and a placed over hurdles. Other female members of the family have produced black-type horses: **Bonaparte Sizing**, a Listed hurdle winner, and **Adagio des Bordes**. On the steeplechase side, **Utopie des Bordes**, winner of the **Prix Maurice Gillois** (Gr.1), stands out alongside her sister **Victoire des Bordes**, who was placed in the **Prix Ferdinand Dufaure** (Gr.1).
