A strong National Hunt market as Rosalina Has tops at €42,000

The newly introduced Auctav January Sale provided the perfect occasion to test the platform's latest innovation: a clear reserve price display, indicating when the reserve had been met. The feature proved invaluable, as Rosalina Has sparked competitive bidding and soared well beyond its mark, selling for €42,000 to CAVA Associates.

Hamel Stud continues its strong form

Carrying a Motivator cover and hailing from an outstanding maternal line known for both performance and breeding success, **Rosalina Has** was presented by Hamel Stud and, after intense bidding, was secured by CAVA Associates for €42,000.

"I'm delighted to have secured Rosalina Has, whom I visited at the stud last week," said Cécile Adonias of CAVA Associates. "She is the third mare we've purchased from Hamel Stud. She has a fantastic pedigree—by Network, with plenty of scope—and ticks all the right boxes to breed for both racing and sales. She will foal down and be covered in France before heading to Ireland."



From the same exceptional maternal family, **Rolanda Has** fetched €26,000, secured by Julien Jouanne.

"It's a top-class family, and I went to see this mare beforehand and really liked her," Jouanne explained. "The fact that she's in foal to Moises Has is an added bonus, as I've heard great things about him. Depending on availability, I hope to send her to either Goliath du Berlais or Jigme."

Stallions: Léon du Berlais attracts Jean-Pierre Coiffier

Auctav offered the first-ever share in exciting young sire **Léon du Berlais**, a unique opportunity that Jean-Pierre Coiffier seized, securing the share through BLM Bloodstock for €26,000.

The half-share in **Cokoriko**, the leading National Hunt sire, was a standout offering due to its rarity on the public market. BLM Bloodstock secured the purchase for €20,000 on behalf of Carlos de Sousa, owner of Hamel Stud.

Meanwhile, JH Bloodstock acquired a **Bubble Gift** share for €15,000. "Bubble Gift introduces Nathaniel's bloodline," said Joffret Huet. "I firmly believe in this stallion's versatility, and I plan to send him a National Hunt mare."

A Functional Flat Sale

On the Flat, the session's top prices came from a broodmare and two juveniles: Onyx, a daughter of Orpen in foal to Goken, was purchased for €17,000 by a group of co-owners. AD Bloodstock acquired two two-year-olds, a Kendargent filly out of Via Gallica, and a Galiway colt out of Golena. These three lots were consigned by Haras de Colleville.

Greater transparency on reserves

Arnaud Angélieaume, Auctav General Manager:

"The January Sale really allowed us to test our new reserve price indicator. We saw significant interest in the live auction feed, not just from active clients but also from those looking to familiarise themselves with the new display. The majority of vendors played along, enabling bidders to clearly see when a lot was officially on the market. This is an initiative we are proud to have introduced, and we are now focused on refining it and further educating users on its benefits. We can already confirm that for the Rouges Terres Sale in April, we will introduce another layer of transparency: in the lead-up to the auction, reserve prices will be published—but only visible to clients with a registered bidder account. This follows a model similar to that used in Japan."
